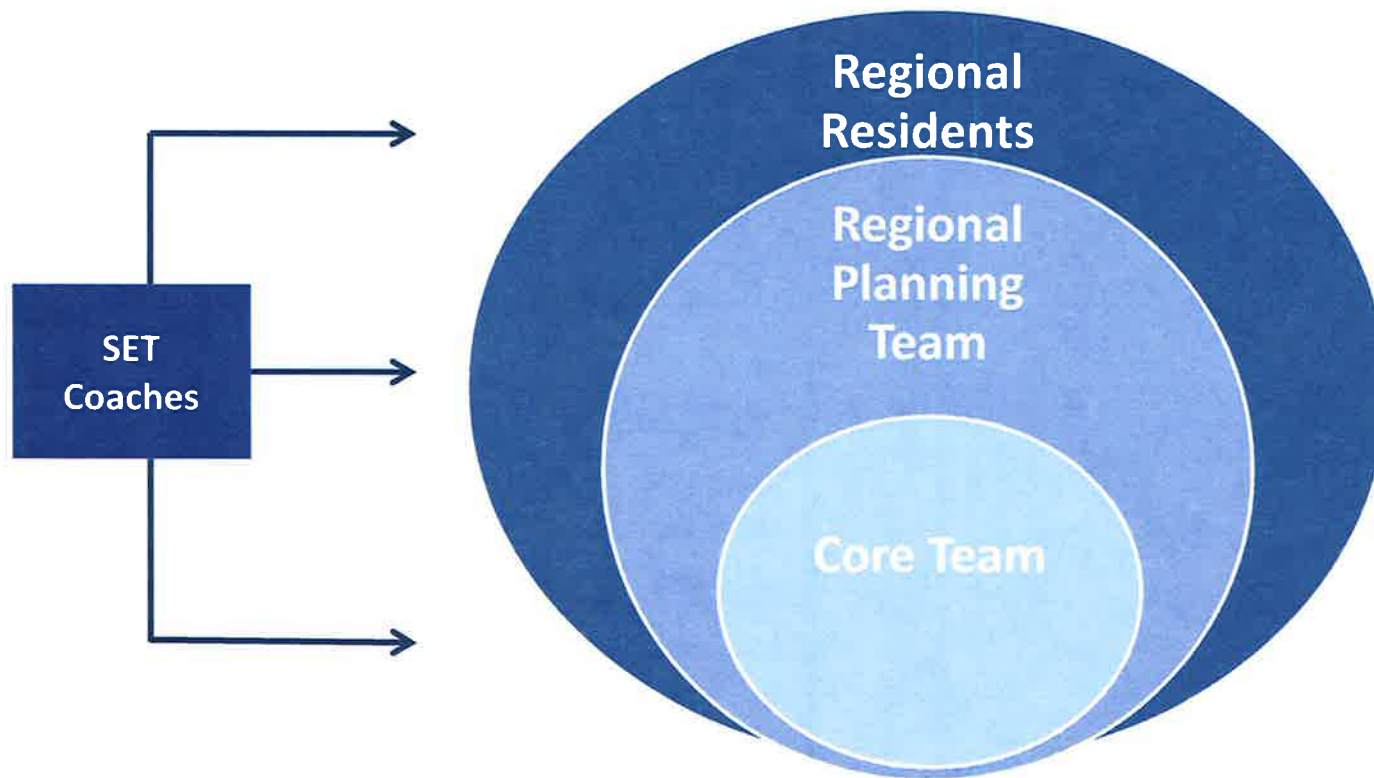




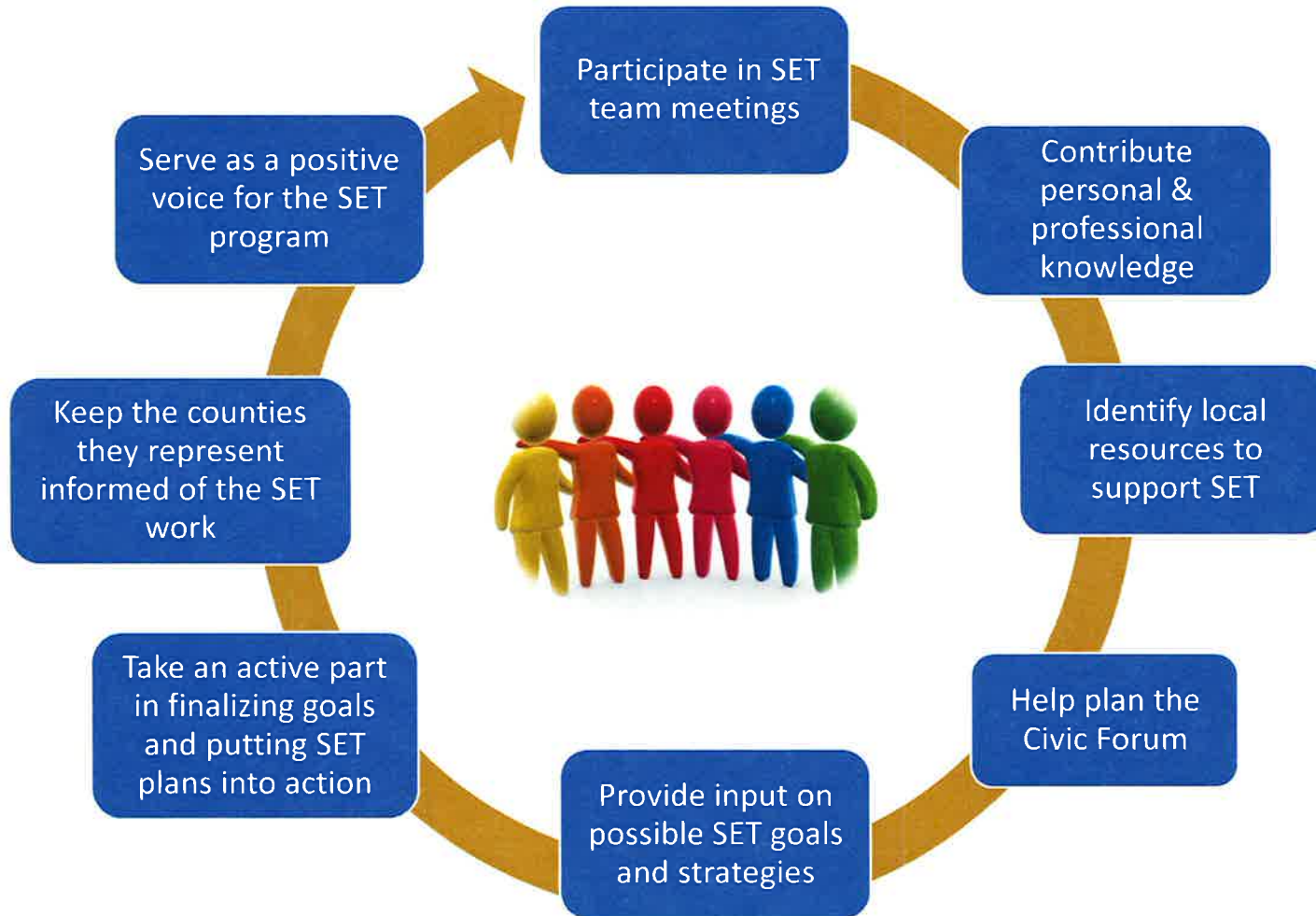
Coordinating the SET Work

Regional Planning Team Responsibilities



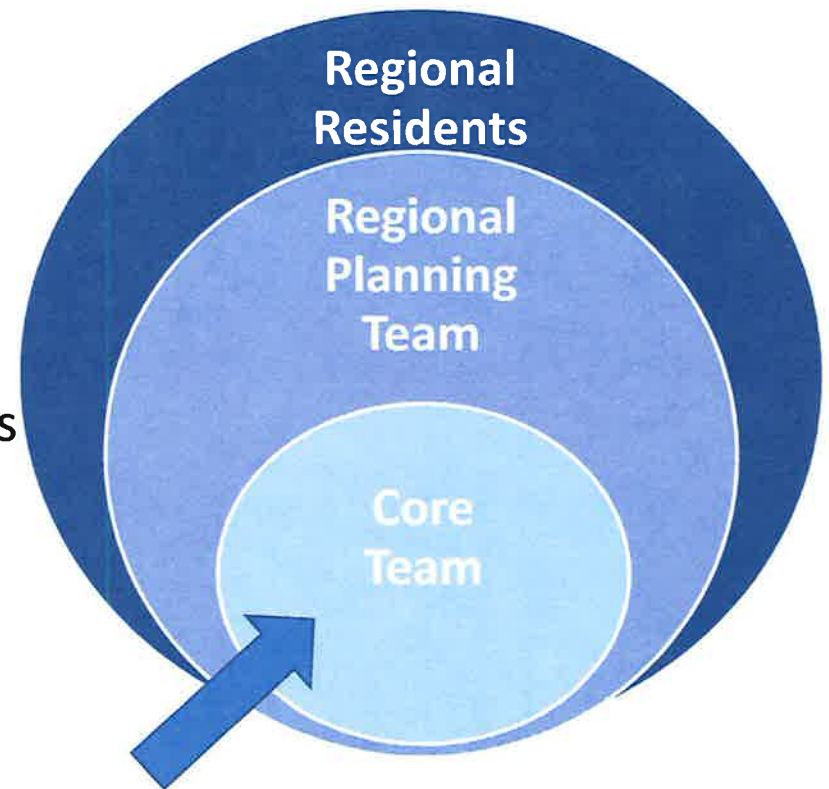
Participants in the Planning Team

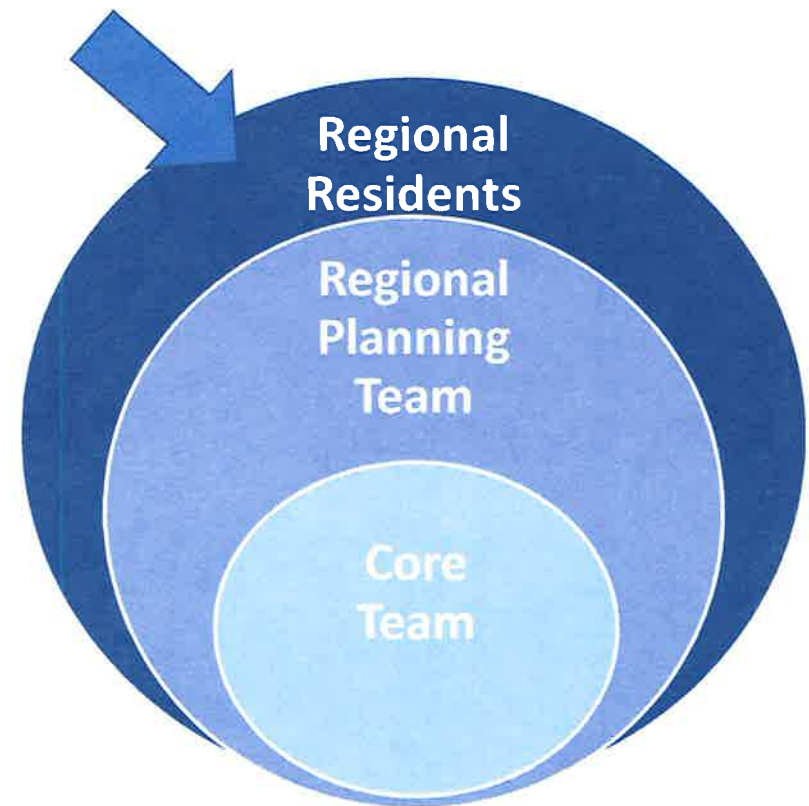
