RESOLUTION No. 19-002

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE
2019 ROADWAY APPLICATION SCHEDULE AND
ROADWAY PROJECT APPLICATION GUIDELINES AND RATING CRITERIA**

WHEREAS, the Southeast Regional Transportation Planning Organization (SERTPO) is a regional transportation planning organization made up of local, county and tribal governments within the counties of Chaves, Curry, De Baca, Eddy, Guadalupe (Town of Vaughn), Lea, Lincoln, Otero and Roosevelt Counties;

WHEREAS, SERTPO carries out specific tasks in accordance with its Cooperative Agreement, entered between the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) and the Southeastern New Mexico Economic Development District (SNMEDD)/ Council of Governments (COG) and Eastern Plains Councils of Governments (EPCOG);

WHEREAS, SERTPO conducts rating and prioritization for local-lead, federally-funded projects under the Roadway Program annually and needs to set and approve new application deadlines in the 2019 Roadway Application Schedule as well as review and approve its roadway rating criteria for its scoring process as outlined in the Roadway Project Application Guidelines and Rating Criteria;

WHEREAS, SERTPO Program Managers have furnished SERTPO Members with an updated 2019 Roadway Application Schedule and Roadway Project Application Guidelines and Rating Criteria, prior to a scheduled SERTPO meeting; and

WHEREAS, SERTPO members have been given the opportunity to comment on the proposed Roadway application timeline and rating criteria during its public meeting on January 3, 2019.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the SERTPO Policy Committee hereby approves the 2019 Roadway Application Schedule and Roadway Project Application Guidelines and Rating Criteria, as provided in meeting packets, reviewed and approved during the January 3, 2019 meeting, and as the 2019 Roadway Application Schedule and Roadway Project Application Guidelines and Rating Criteria may have been amended during the January meeting.
